Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. The one who does not love does know God, for God is love.


1 John 4:7-8


All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. Isaiah 53:6 (KJV)
