Worship: More than Sunday Morning?

I. A Definition (Ps 96:1-13)

Worship is a <u>reverent</u> response to an <u>awareness</u> of God's <u>presence</u> that acknowledges His <u>greatness</u>.

Worship should be by everyone, everywhere, and all the time.

II. An Application (John 4:23-24; Romans 12:1)
