2. Read Luke 1:41-43. How did Elizabeth know what had happened to Mary? How did she react?

Ponder your salvation and the significance of Christ's coming in relation to it. What thoughts arise? Any emotion too?

3. In Luke 1:44-45 Elizabeth tells Mary what the Holy Spirit revealed to her. What does she tell Mary she should be happy about? What does she commend Mary for?

Are you happy about the same thing Mary was to be happy about? Do you show it, and if so, how?

Would you be commended for the same thing Mary was commended for? Explain.

4. How well do you celebrate Christmas? Is there anything you learned from the example of Elizabeth that can help you celebrate Christmas better?
