The Background:

I. The Promise (67-75)

<u>Praise</u> God for keeping His promise to <u>send</u> a <u>Savior</u> to <u>save</u> us.

II. The Preparation (76-79)

*<u>Forgiveness</u>* of *<u>sin</u> is necessary for the <i>peace* of salvation.

5. Read Luke 1:78-79. Why was God sending the Savior?

How can this encourage you in what you need God to save you from?

Write a statement from why God was sending the Savior that you could share with a friend or neighbor to move them closer to salvation through Christ. (Use the word "us" rather than "you")
