Remember: We are studying a new book of the Bible, Titus. It is actually a letter written by a man named Paul to Titus helping him lead the church on the island of Crete.

This week, Paul warns Titus of people that claim to know God but their actions do not show that. These are people who lie, disobey what God tells them, and try to trick others to following them instead of God.

The Bible tells us multiple times how to show that we know and love God through our actions. Here are a few:

John 14:15 "If you love me, keep my commands."

James 1:22 But be doers of the word and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

1 John 3:18 Dear children let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth.

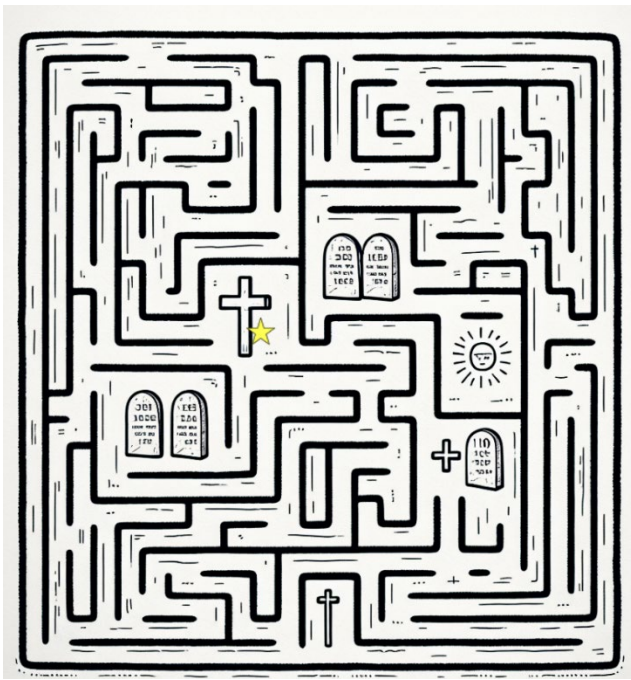

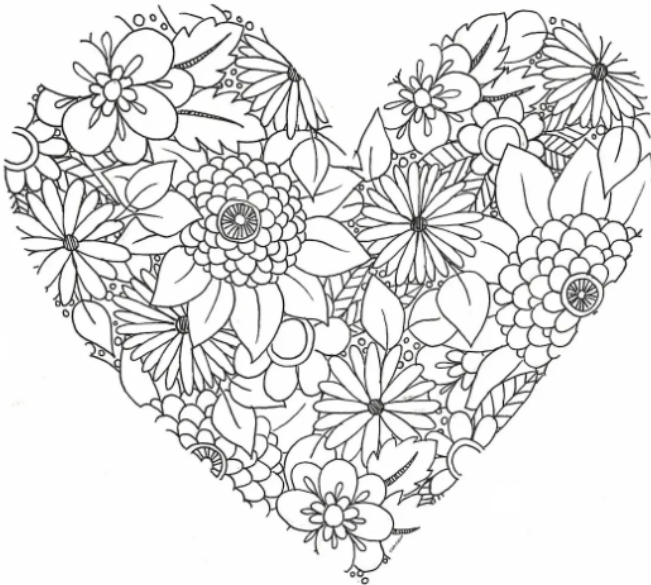
