3. In Philemon 1:12-17 we see Paul's appeal. What is it? Why would this be a difficult appeal for Philemon to hear?

Have you been wronged by someone who was, or now is, a Christian? What does the book of Philemon teach you about how you should respond toward that person and why?

4. Read Philemon 1:18-25. How does Paul show the importance of his appeal to Philemon? How does he add a little extra motivation for Philemon to grant his request?

Can you give an example of how you helped someone, or someone helped you, do the right thing as a Christian, even though the right thing was very hard?

What reason(s) do you have for doing what's right in God's eyes?
