I. A Reminder (1-2)

Remember to show grace toward all people.

II. A Recall (3)

Remember, you needed mercy yourself.

III. A Responsibility (4-7)

Use good deeds to show others the grace and mercy of God in salvation.

1. Read Titus 3:1-2. What did Paul want Titus to remind the Cretans about? Why might that have been his concern?

2. In Titus 3:3 Paul reminds Titus that every believer has needed God's mercy. Think about your life before Christ's work in you, or what might have characterized your life. What would your life be like now without His mercy?

3. Read Titus 3:4-8.

What does Paul remind Titus of? (verses 4-6)

What purpose of God in saving people is given in verse 7?

What additional purpose of God in saving people is given in verse 8?

4. Give a few examples of good deeds you can do to demonstrate the grace and mercy of God in salvation. How will those who see it know this isn't just because you're a great person?
