3. In 3 John 9-10 we read about Diotrephes. What was the major issue with Diotrephes and how does a church guard against having a Diotrephes in a highly-influential position?
4. 3 John 11 tells us to imitate what is good. Who are some of the people in your life that you are trying to imitate? In what ways?
5. Of the nine examples of Christian love in the text, which will you pray for and work on most this week in your life?
