1. Read Jeremiah 23:1-4. What problem is being pointed out? What did God say He did and would do?

2. Jeremiah tells of a future time in Jeremiah 23:5-8. How is that time described?

3. Read Matthew 2:1-2. What are some of the details in these verses that show God is revealing Jesus as the promised coming Messiah King?

Think back over your life. What were some of the key moments when God used something or someone to draw your heart and attention toward Him as Lord? How did you respond? Was there a lasting change?

4. Read John 1:44-49. Why was it hard for Nathanael to believe the son of a man named Joseph could be the promised Messiah King? What was Philip's method of convincing him?

What did Jesus reveal about Himself to Nathanael?

How does knowing this about Jesus affect your daily life?
